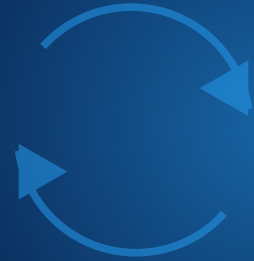

Why this programme

Agile is now the default way software, digital and change projects are run in the UK, and AgilePM® is the framework that puts a governance structure around it. It is the qualification employers ask for when a project needs to move quickly without losing control.

This programme takes you from no experience through to job ready. It is delivered online and self paced, so you study around work, family or resettlement rather than taking time off. The recommended study time across the four courses and the assessments is around 105 hours.

The two official examinations included in the price are AgilePM® Foundation and AgilePM® Practitioner. Change Management Foundation and Lean Six Sigma Green Belt are studied as accredited courses within the programme; their examinations are not included and can be added at any time through our exam booking team.

Support at every stage

Self paced does not mean on your own. This is the part that decides whether people finish, and it is the difference between a course and a folder of videos.

1 Mentorship

A designated project management mentor is your main point of contact throughout, by phone, email and video call. Which order to take the courses in, when you are genuinely ready to sit an exam, and whether the role you are aiming at is realistic from where you are standing. No question is too simple or too complex.

2 Exam and assessment support

Revision questions, quizzes, mock papers and guidance from your mentor for both official examinations. You also complete project assessments that test your understanding of the methodology, which is what gives you a real sense of managing a project rather than reading about one.

3 A qualified tutor

Alongside your mentor you have a qualified tutor for the course material itself: the parts of the syllabus that do not land first time, the questions that come up while you are working through a module, and the detail behind an exam answer you got wrong.

4 Dedicated career support

Once your training and assessments are complete our recruitment team steps in with a professional CV rewrite, interview preparation and personalised job search support.

Projects and what comes next

The assessments sit inside the programme, then recruitment support begins once your examinations are passed.

1 AgilePM in practice

2 Project management assessments

Applied assessments across the key areas of project management. This is where everything you have learned comes together, and where you build the examples an interviewer will ask you for.

About the roles

Project management is a career ladder rather than a single job. Where you start is not where you stay, and the step up from support roles into delivery roles is one of the more reliable progressions in UK white collar work.

01 Needed across every sector

IT, construction, healthcare, finance and the public sector all run projects and all need people who can run them properly.

02 You do not need a degree

The profession hires on method, certification and demonstrated delivery. That is what makes it reachable from any background.

03 More than one job at the end

Project support, project coordination, junior project manager, change and portfolio roles. Several doors, not one.

04 The skills are evergreen

Structured delivery does not go out of date, and demand grows as more organisations adopt formal project methods.

05 Genuine progression

Support administrator to analyst to project manager to portfolio and PMO leadership is a well worn route with a clear pay ladder.

06 From global brands to startups

Project managers are needed everywhere, which widens the roles you can realistically apply for and where you can live.

A ladder is not a starting salary. Starting salaries for project support roles are up to £30,000 and are location dependent, and the higher figures reflect several years of delivery experience. Certification improves your chances of being considered for a role. It does not on its own set your pay.

Frequently asked questions

How does the Guaranteed Route to Job Placement work?

On completion of the programme our recruitment team works with you to secure your first role: professional CV rewrite, LinkedIn guidance, interview preparation and help applying consistently. If you have met the programme conditions and have not secured a role, that support continues. The full conditions are set out in our Terms & Conditions, and we would rather you read them before enrolling than after.

Are the two examinations really included in the price?

Yes. AgilePM® Foundation and AgilePM® Practitioner are both included in the £2,695 programme price, however you choose to pay. Change Management Foundation and Lean Six Sigma Green Belt are included as accredited courses; their examinations are optional extras you can add at any time.

Are your courses accredited?

We are a CMI, APMG, PeopleCert and BCS authorised training centre, and every course in this package is either APMG or PeopleCert accredited. AgilePM® is awarded by APMG, not by us, so your qualification is worth exactly the same as it would be from any other provider and it stays with you.

Can anyone join this programme?

Yes. You do not need prior project experience. What you do need is organisation, confidence with people and the drive to keep studying around whatever else you have on.

How long does the programme take?

The recommended study time is around 105 hours in total across the four courses and the assessments, which most people spread across four to six months around a job. You have a full year of access.

Can I pay monthly?

Yes. You can pay in full or spread the cost monthly over up to 48 months. Finance is provided by Snap Finance Limited, authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority under firm reference number 741813. Course Correct Ltd is a credit broker and not a lender. Then AgilePM® Practitioner, which teaches you how to apply and tailor AgilePM® appropriately, then Change Management Foundation, and lastly the Lean Six Sigma Green Belt. Alongside these you complete the project management assessments. Your tutor can give you more detailed advice for your own situation.

Can I use these qualifications outside the UK?

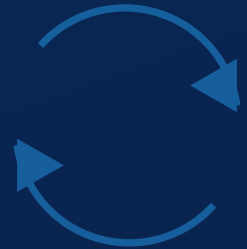
The courses are UK based but internationally recognised. AgilePM® is accredited by APMG International and is one of the most widely adopted Agile project frameworks worldwide.
